Instructions:

Full Cross Stitch

Be sure that all your stitches lie in the same direction. Bottom stitches should lie from bottom left to upper right and top stitches from bottom right to upper left. Work stitches from the bottom to the top of the stitch, from left to right, then cross them as you work from right to left, still coming up at the bottom of each stitch and going down at the top.

Three Quarter Stitches

These are used in the eyes to get the shape. They work much the same as the Full Cross Stitch except that one stitch will only go to the centre of the block, while the other one stitch will go the from corner to corner. You then match this in the other half of the block with the colour surrounding the eye. Three quarter stitches are shown by having a block divided in two with a smaller symbol in each half.
